- Submission of full papers: April 1st 2016.

Registration fee:

Basic (compulsory) part of the registration fee

Registration fee: 100 € per paper. For participants from Serbia, there is a possibility of payment in dinars.

Basic (compulsory) part of the registration fee includes:

- Publication of full papers in the Proceedings of the symposium.
- Proceedings of full papers and all other promotional materials - one set per article.
- Presentation of papers and attending all the symposium sections.
- Snacks and refreshments during breaks.

Optional part of the registration fee

Registration fee: 150 € per person. For participants from Serbia, there is a possibility of payment in dinars.

Optional part of the registration fee includes:

- Two dinners (16th and 17th June 2016).
- Two lunches (17th and 18th June 2016).
- Cruising by the Bay of Kotor (18th June 2016).

Further information regarding fees:

- Registration fee does not include accommodation and travel costs.
- Registration fee includes VAT.
- Payments can be performed on Faculty's account upon the invoice issued after submitting the paper.

Abstract and paper submission:

- Paper registration and abstract submission is performed by filling out the form attached to the First Call.

Papers:

- Official conference language is English.
- All the papers will be classified in Plenary and separate parallel sections.
- The papers for Plenary session will be provided by Organizing committee upon invitation.
- All papers are to be received in anticipated terms and reviewed.
- All reviewed and accepted full papers will be published in Proceedings.
- Papers should be sent by e-mail on the following e-mail address: emc@tfzr.uns.ac.rs
- Papers should be formatted according to the instruction which can be found on: www.tfzr.uns.ac.rs/emc

Types of paper presentations:

- Oral presentation (by the Program of Symposium and in duration that is no longer than 10 minutes).
- Poster presentation (up to 3 slides, which in .ppt or .pdf format should be sent to the Organizer).
